Located in one of America's fastest growing retail communities, Freeport Crossing is an award winning outlet store that includes forty-eight-thousand square feet of retail space. Based on the local vernacular three individual building scales were used to provide a community of familiar-feeling structures for this retail enclave. At the western gateway to Freeport the project creates a civilized link between the vernacular and retail fundamentals with display windows, maximum signage and ease of access. Using the unique sculptural shapes of the wall surfaces themselves, rather than signage, the complex is clearly identified and visible from I-95. Freeport Crossing leases space to several of the nation's leading upscale retail establishments.

In 1987, Freeport Crossing received the coveted design award from the Maine Chapter of the American Institute of Architects.
